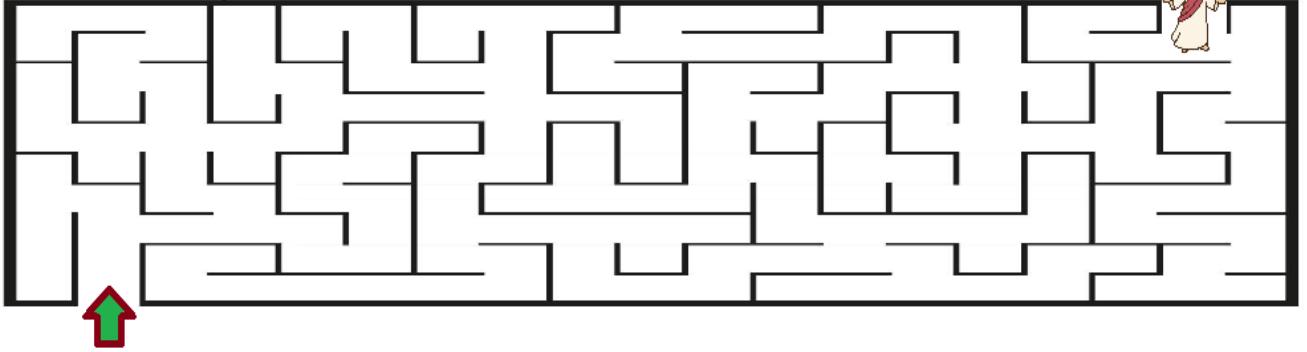
Children: remember to collect your (non-edible) daffodil bulbs after Mass

November: Month of Holy Souls. Nov begins with the **Solemnity of All Saints' (1 Nov)**, followed by the **'Commemoration of all the Faithful Departed: All Souls' Day' on 2 Nov**. Both these days mark the start of a 'Month of the Holy Souls'. You are invited to present names of deceased family & friends who died in the last 12 months in the envelopes provided, and Masses will be offered for them throughout the month. On **2 Nov**, there will be a special Mass of Remembrance and Healing for families of the living and the dead. November is also a good time for people to visit and pray at the graves of their loved ones. We will do this on Sunday **3 Nov at Cookham (2pm)** and **10 Nov Braywick (2pm)**.
