# Peace be to this house!

Jesus sends out seventy-two of his followers ahead of him to every town and place. We hear that they return with joy, knowing that they've been able to heal the sick and that even the demons have become subject to them when they commanded them in the name of Jesus.

But perhaps the most important message that they are to take with them is one of peace: This peace is not merely an absence of fighting or squabbles. It is "shalom" – a wholeness, completion or flourishing.

The promise of peace that runs through the entire Old Testament finds its fulfilment in the very person of Jesus. He has broken down the dividing wall of hostility among people, reconciling them with God.

On the eve of his death, Jesus speaks of his loving relation with the Father and the unifying power that this love bestows upon his disciples. The gift of peace is the seal on his spiritual testament: "Peace I leave with you; my peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you". The words of the Risen Lord will not be any different; every time that he meets his disciples they receive from him the greeting and gift of peace: "Peace be with you".

The invitation this weekend is to receive the peace which the Risen Christ wishes to bring to your house. Will you let Him enter and fill you with his presence, allowing his peace to "guard your heart and mind"? And a further invitation for you to be a channel, an instrument, an emissary of peace. Will you take the peace of the Risen Lord out like a river into the troubled places of our villages, towns, cities and world?

Will you take Jesus Himself, given to you fully in the Eucharist, wherever you find yourself this week?
