The gospel reports the hospitality shown to Jesus by Martha and Mary, but the two sisters welcome him in different ways. Mary gives Jesus her full attention, sitting at the Lord's feet like a student rabbi learning from a Master. In the same way, Paul sat at the feet of rabbi Gamaliel as a disciple.

Meanwhile Martha is distracted with a great deal of serving. She wants everything to be right to welcome such an important guest, so she bustles around. Because she has so many details to worry about, she is resentful that her sister has left her alone to do all the serving.

The Bible says "One thing is necessary" - The one thing necessary is to listen to God's word and put it into practice. It is certainly important to serve others, as the good Samaritan had done in the previous week, but we all have a basic need to listen to God's word. During the holiday season, when we often have a break from the bustle of work, let us give some time for listening to the Lord.

Christ, who inspires our prayers by the Holy Spirit, may make them bear fruit in works of charity and justice.






