In today's Gospel, we are reminded of the importance of bringing God's compassionate love and care to those who are less fortunate than we are. Just as in Jesus' time, many people today lack the basic necessities for a decent life. We don't have to look far to see those who are deprived in various ways. It is important to recognize that this deprivation is not only material; it extends to all aspects of our human existence. We should not only feel pity for the poor; we must also show genuine mercy and compassion towards them. This kind of mercy involves a personal concern that requires us to give not just from our abundance but also from the very little that we hold dear.

Jesus Christ provides us with the perfect example of how to bring God's mercy to the poor. Though He was rich, He became poor - so that by His poverty, we might become rich. Sometimes in life we may think that the making of money and the accumulation of wealth may provide us with a sense of security and freedom, but these cannot become an end in themselves. They can provide us with a temporary sense of peace and happiness, but ultimately, they do not provide true peace and happiness. As human beings, made in the image and likeness of God, we are not truly satisfied until we find our rest in God. During the celebration of the liturgy, we accept God's grace, pardon and mercy.
