Faith teaches us that our lives as Christians are about being always grateful for the privilege of being one with Jesus in his work of making God's love a reality in the world. And this privilege fills us with hope and joy. It is not about power, possessions, pleasure, status or reputation.

Our tradition teaches us that an aspect of faith is an occasional sense of God's absence. This can take many forms like a search for identity, despair, difficulty in prayer or finding it impossible and even frustration or rejection with the Church. While it is hard to bear, St. Therese of Lisieux saw these times as moments when we are called to persevere in trust.

As Jesus makes clear in the Gospel, faith opens our lives and actions to the possibility of benefitting from the immense power of the Holy Spirit. While we may not move mountains, faith and trust in Jesus will reward us with unexpected and surprising miracles. Faith is a gift that lives in, and nurtured by living in a community. That is why regular celebration of the Eucharist and continual reflection on the Word is nourishing and crucial.

As important aspect of opening our lives to the power of faith is willingness to let go, that life is a journey in which dying and rising are continual realities. The Cross teaches us the way to live and to love.

While we are deeply concerned about the state of the world, we remember that Jesus shares their suffering, and, as disciples, we have a responsibility to pray and work for peace, and in that prayer to unite ourselves with those who are victims of war and violence.
