The central issue in today's narratives of leprosy is that of fear, rejection and ostracisation, and being deemed 'unclean'. Of the ten men Jesus healed directly, only one man - a Samaritan (foreigner) - turned back to acknowledge his healing, praising God for the gift, and presumably future restoration to his former status. The other nine, who were probably of the Jewish faith, did not return to give thanks. These men took their healing for granted and perhaps saw the healing as a form of magic, whereas the Samaritan saw the deeper reality of his healing, namely the power of God at work in Jesus, and a recognition of his salvation through this encounter. Our Catholic faith and practice is not merely 'another religion, nor even a 'how to get to heaven' handbook. Our Faith is unique and uniquely true: it is the coming of God into this world with the divine intent to 'divinise' humankind, to make humanity 'sharers of his divine nature' - 'Theosis' in Greek. It is what the Gospel and the sacraments are all about. It is, ultimately what we mean when we speak of 'Salvation.' As blessing and thanksgiving are central to Christian prayer, let us bless God for everything, always: Although you have no need of our praise,

> yet our thanksgiving is itself your gift, since our praises add nothing to your greatness but profit us for salvation, through Christ our Lord.


