Advent has a twofold character, for it is a time of preparation for the Solemnities of Christmas, in which the First Coming of the Son of God to humanity is remembered, and likewise a time when, by remembrance of this, minds and hearts are led to look forward to Christ's Second Coming at the end of time. For these two reasons, Advent is a period of devout and expectant delight.

Today's readings point the "stump of Jesse", which brings to mind the forlorn sight of the stump of the tree cut down in the Sycamore Gap by Hadrian's Wall. But there are signs of hope; saplings are growing! Surely, hope is the keynote of the reading from Isaiah which ends with a vision of paradise restored. John the Baptist emerging from the wilderness calls us to repent of the wilderness in our lives, to prepare a way for the Lord by seeking forgiveness for our sins. Then, at a time of year when we can feel pressured, we can live with hope and expectation. We can live in harmony with one another and welcome one another because Jesus is near to us.

In St Joseph's: The Children's Liturgy Advent Theme is 'Jesus's family tree' (aka Jesse tree). At every Advent Sunday, we will read a Bible story about someone on Jesus's family tree and hang an ornament symbolising the story on our Jesse Tree.
