The liturgical celebration of today emphasizes joy and anticipation as we prepare for the coming of Christ into our hearts anew at Christmas and finally at the end of time in his kingly glory. It is for this reason that this third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday, which means "Rejoice" in Latin. This Sunday reminds us that even in our waiting, we can find joy in the hope of the Lord's coming. For this reason, we are invited to rejoice always. No matter the darkness that surrounds us resulting perhaps from our own sins and/or the sins of the society, we need to remain joyful and hopeful because God, in His Son Jesus, is always drawing close to help us. Joy is not dependent on our circumstances but on our relationship with God who is capable of transforming our loneliness, fruitlessness, our fatigue and hunger into an experience of bliss, justice and light.

Filled with joy at the thought that the Lord is near, we have to continue waiting in patience and trust. Like John the Baptist, we need to yearn for the Lord's coming with joy and anticipation even in the midst of our chains. Jesus performs miracles and sends John's messengers to report to John what they have seen. Even in doubt and pain, we can find reassurance in the signs of God's presence around us. This evokes joy and patience.

O God, who see how your people faithfully await the feast of the Lord's Nativity, enable us, we pray, to attain the joys of so great a salvation and to celebrate them always with solemn worship and glad rejoicing.

Colours of Advent:


Rose represents joy and reveals a shift away from repentance and toward celebration.

Confirmation & First Holy Communion Classes: As you may be aware, the Confirmation and FHC journeys are in three stages. Stage 1: come to Mass for the last number of months and participating in the prayers and singing, and being comfortable with the journey of liturgy. At the end of each Mass, the candidates received an attendance stamp. This will continue. The family/child will need to show the priest or catechist their Mass Attendance Card. If there is consistency, then the child will be invited into Stage Two, which are the classes. If not, and there seems no interest in Mass attendance, then the child and family will be asked to postpone the reception of the Sacrament for another year.

 **FHC Stage 2:** First class in **SJ: 9.30am 11 Jan** / SEC: 4.30pm 10 Jan. Classes will be followed by Mass and official enrolment for the First Holy Communion programme.

 **Confirmation Stage 2** Eligible Candidates will begin this stage **Saturday 24 Jan 4.30pm at SEC** school. Bring along your Mass attendance cards. A letter and an update of dates have been sent out to their families recently. Please note the requirements to enter Stage Two of the programme. We continue to pray for them.

 **OCIA:** We are blessed with having eighteen candidates join the OCIA (Order of Christian Initiation of Adults). These are made up of people from Holy Family Parish, Maidenhead & Twyford. They are all involved with our church community. Some desire to be baptised, others to be received into the Catholic church from another church, and some are Catholics who desire to complete their Initiation process by the Sacrament of Confirmation. All we be fully initiated at the Easter Vigil, April 4th, 2026. Classes are beginning. We continue to pray for them.
